NOTICE is hereby given that a Regular Meeting of the Board of Commissioners of Comal County Emergency Services District No. 1 will be held Thursday, June 23, 2022 beginning at 4:00p.m., at the Bulverde Spring Branch Fire & EMS Station 1, Conference Room, 353 Rodeo Drive, Spring Branch, TX, 78070 for the following purposes:

DISCUSSION / ACTION ITEMS

- 1) Call meeting to order, prayer; Public Comments: Members of the public may collectively address the Board for a total of thirty minutes on items not on the current agenda (i.e. the public comment section of the meeting). Individual members of the public may address the Board for a maximum of three minutes on items not on the current agenda (i.e. the public comment section of the meeting). Individual members of the public may address the Board for a maximum of three minutes per person per agenda item. Individuals may address the Board once per item. Members of the public may collectively address the Board for a total of thirty minutes per item on the agenda. Members of the public will speak on an agenda item after comments on the item is called for by the presiding officer, but before Board discussion and consideration of the item. Speakers will be called upon in the order that they signed up to speak on an item. If more than ten speakers sign up to speak on an agenda item or as part of public comment on items not on the agenda item, each speaker's allotted time will be proportionally reduced to allow all speakers an opportunity to speak within the 30-minute time limit.

- 3) Review and discuss the Chief's monthly report – All Commissioners

- 4) Review, consider and accept monthly financial reports, Kay Derrich – All Commissioners

- 5) Consider and approve bills/invoices to be paid – All Commissioners

- 6) Discuss and Approve Amended 2022 Budget, including a proposed 13% compensation increase to BSBES staff for August 1, 2022, and costs associated with CAD implementation.

- 7) Discuss and present for vote BSBES Board recommendations for staffing increase as follows:
Stations 2, 3, and 4, 6 staff per shift, station 5- 2 staff per shift and station 1- 7 per shift

- 8) Update and Discuss ongoing contract negotiations for the purchase of 10 acres at 27450 State Hwy 46, to include residential and well inspections, water test and survey. Status on Rivermont POA property engagement – All Commissioners

- 9) Discuss BSBES recommendation for creating new Admin / Management and Command positions.

- 10) Update on Department Vehicles – Chief Torres

- 11) Receive and discuss progress reports from the BSBES board /standing ESD committees, address the need for commissioners to attend assigned committees. - All Commissioners

- 12) Adjourn and set next meeting date for July 2022, – All Commissioners.

If the Board decides to enter executive session regarding any item on this agenda, the Presiding Officer will announce that an executive session will be held and will identify the item to be discussed and the provision from the Open Meeting Act that authorizes the closed or executive session.
